

The SIOP Foundation announces the Dunnette Prize

The Dunnette Prize, named for Marvin D. Dunnette, honors living originators of fundamental advances focused on research, development, or application that has expanded knowledge of the causal significance of individual differences. Given every 3-5 years, depending on the size of the endowment, this substantial prize will first be given when the endowment reaches a level that permits a \$50,000 cash award to be made and an honoree who meets the criteria has been identified.

Contribute to the Dunnette Prize Endowment Fund

Individual and corporate gifts to the Dunnette Prize Endowment Fund are tax-deductible:

- Charter Contributors, donors who contribute at or above \$1,000, will have their names included in announcements about the Dunnette Prize.
- Founding Contributors, donors who contribute at or above \$10,000, will be invited to attend events or receptions honoring Dunnette Prize winners.
- Major Contributors, giving \$25,000 or more, will be asked to recommend SIOP members to serve on the Dunnette Prize Award Selection Committee.
- Lead Contributors, contributing \$100,000 or more, will be granted lifetime authority to name a member to the Dunnette Prize Award Selection Committee each year that it is convened.
- Other contributions, less than \$1,000, are also welcome.
