SIOP MEMBERSHIP SNAPSHOT

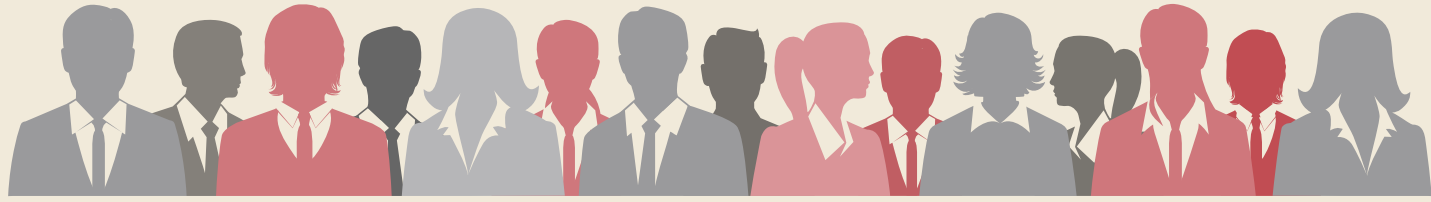

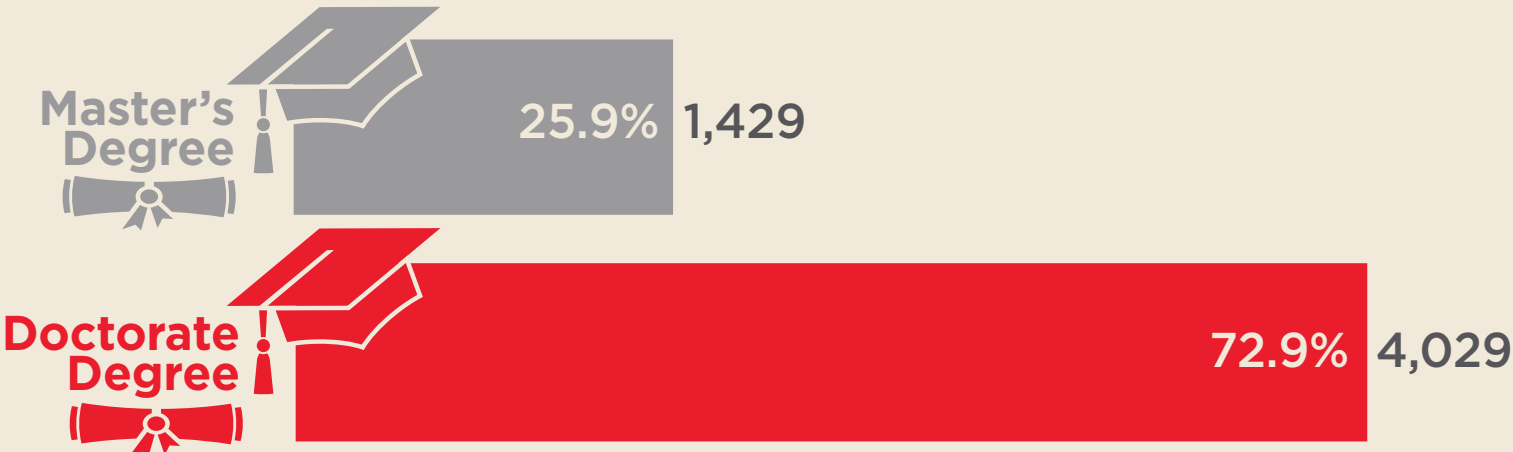

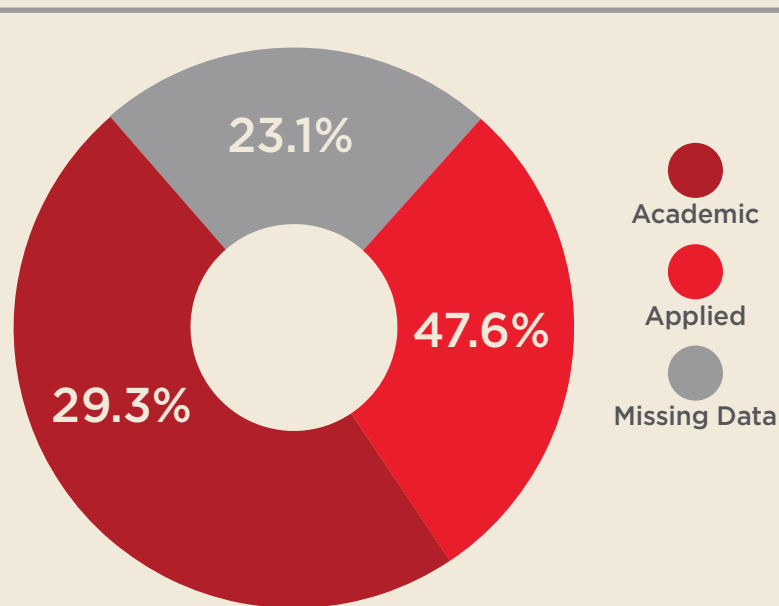
SCIENCE FOR A SMARTER WORKPLACE

Degrees Held By SIOP Non-Student Members



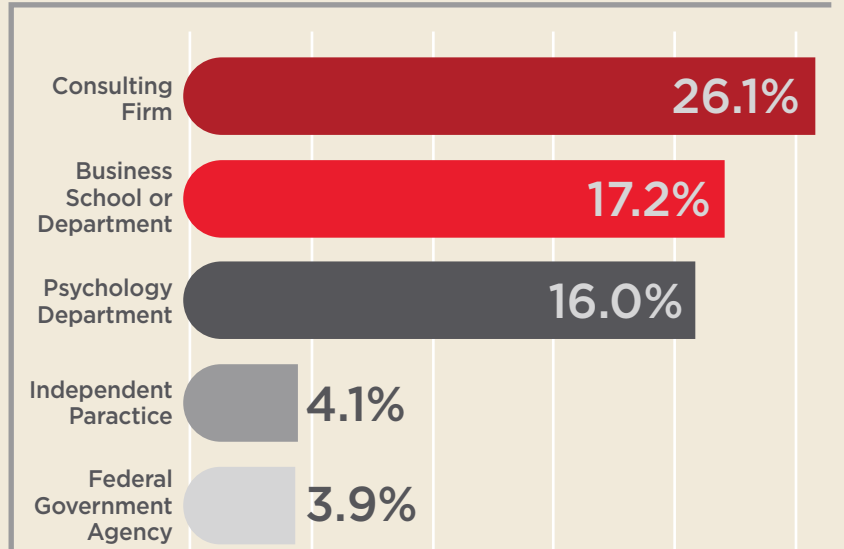

Work Sectors Among SIOP Non-Student Members



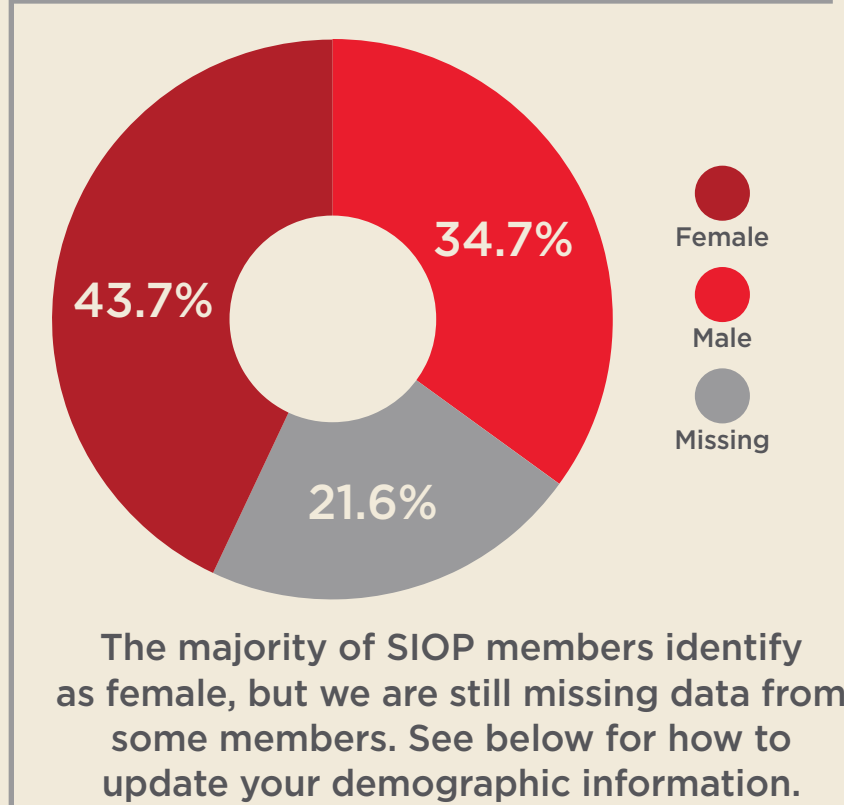
There is a growing trend of non-student SIOP members working in applied fields more than academic fields.

Top Five Main Industries Among SIOP Non-Student Members



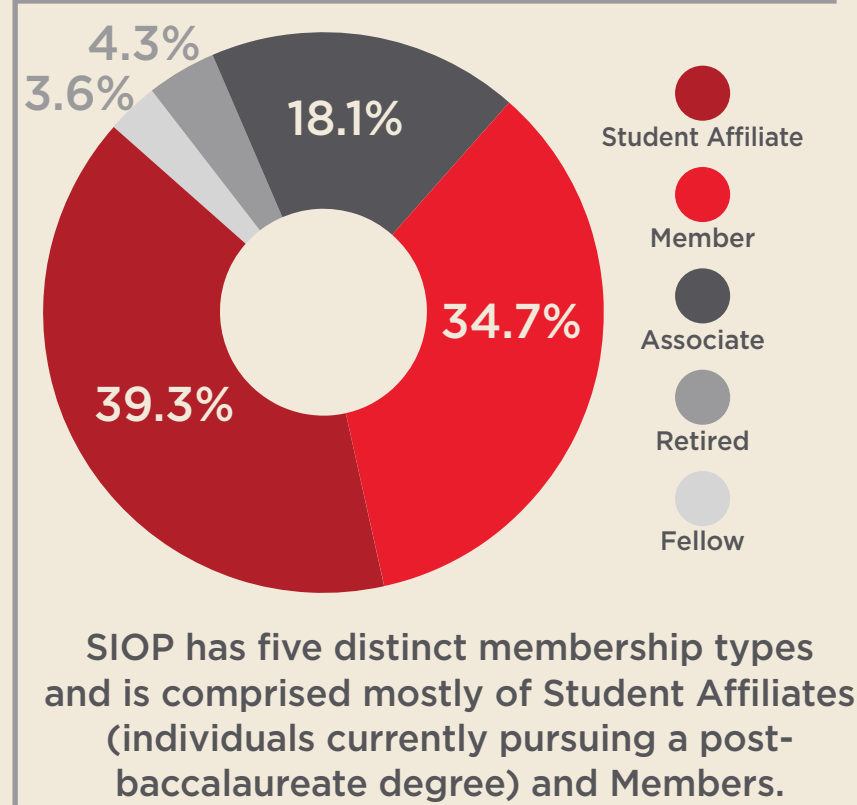
Most non-student SIOP members work in consulting, followed by academia and then independent practice and government work.

Gender Composition of SIOP Membership



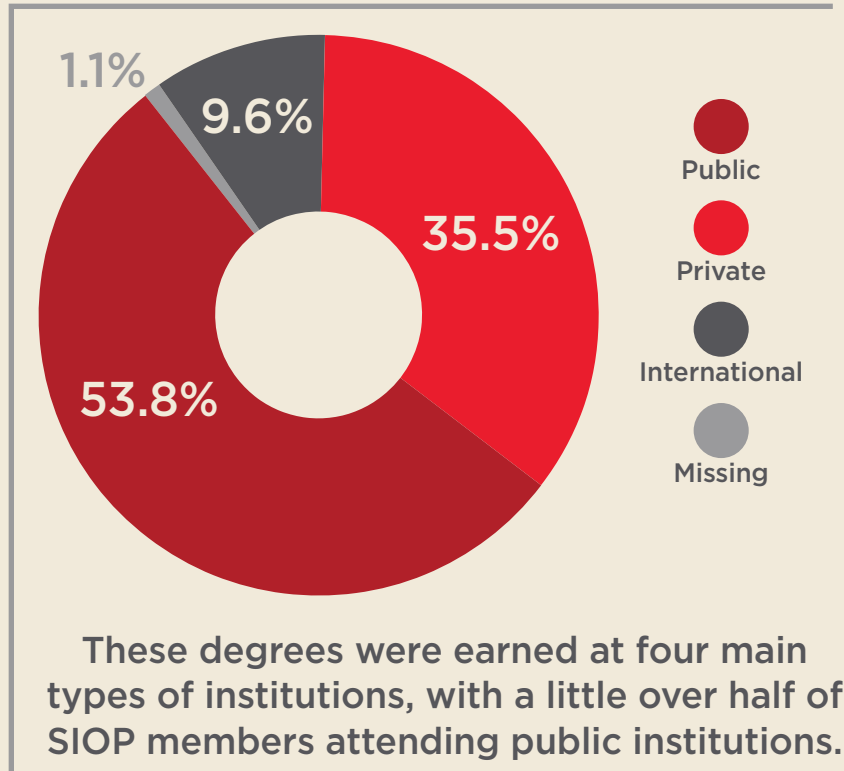
The majority of SIOP members identify as female, but we are still missing data from some members. See below for how to update your demographic information.

Membership Categories for SIOP Members



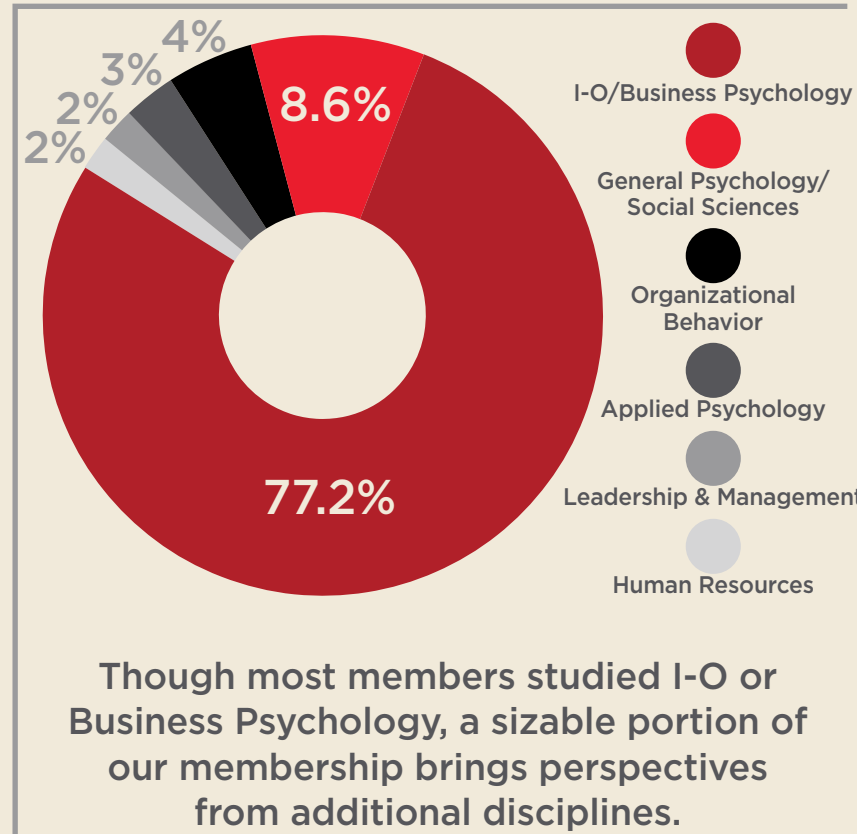
SIOP has five distinct membership types and is comprised mostly of Student Affiliates (individuals currently pursuing a post-baccalaureate degree) and Members.

Top Six Areas of Study at Attended Institutions



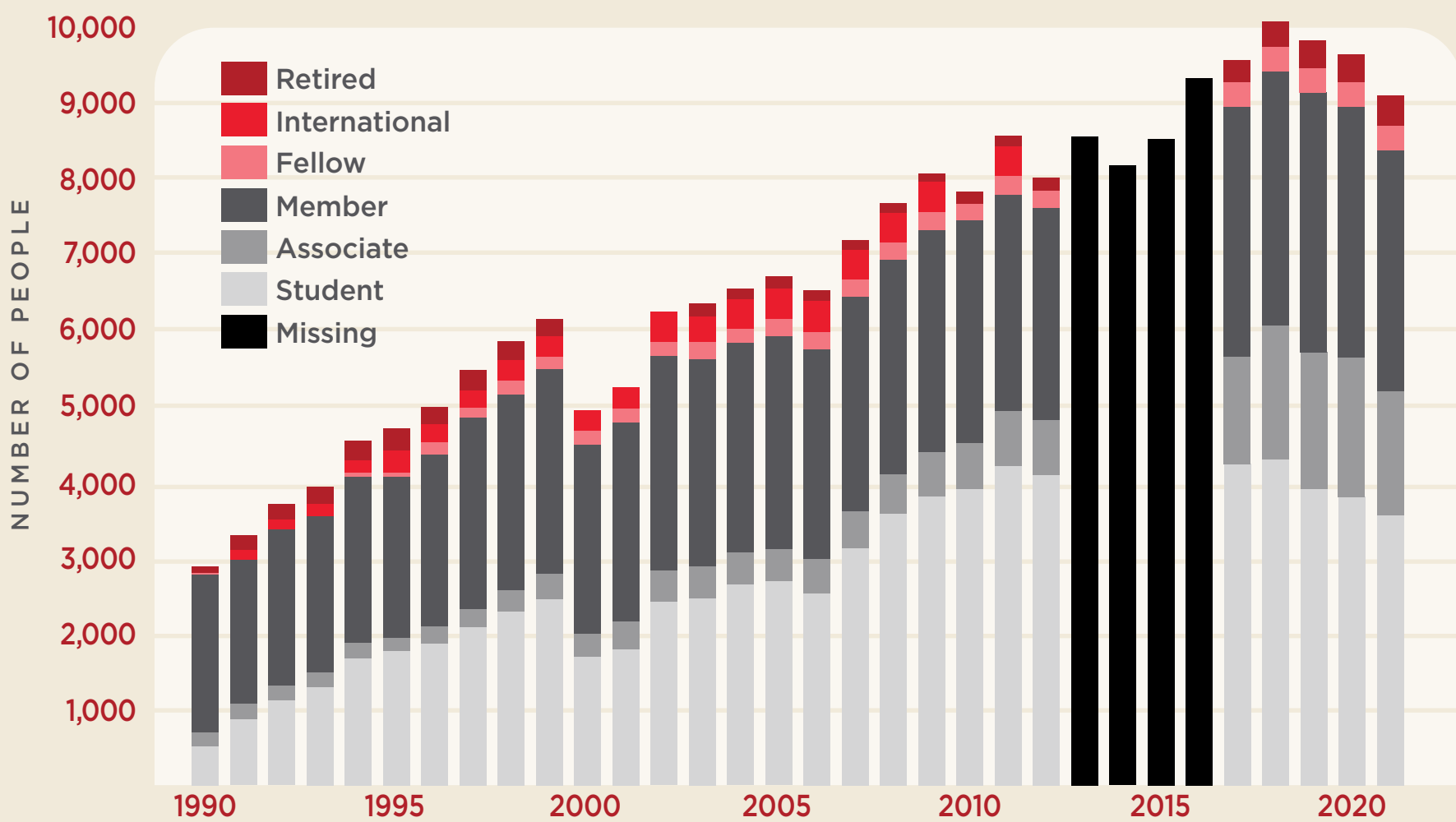
Though most members studied I-O or Business Psychology, a sizable portion of our membership brings perspectives from additional disciplines.

SIOP MEMBERSHIP TRENDS

A glance at membership dating back to 1990 shows that there has been an overall increase in the membership base,* with membership leveling off in recent years around 9,000 members.

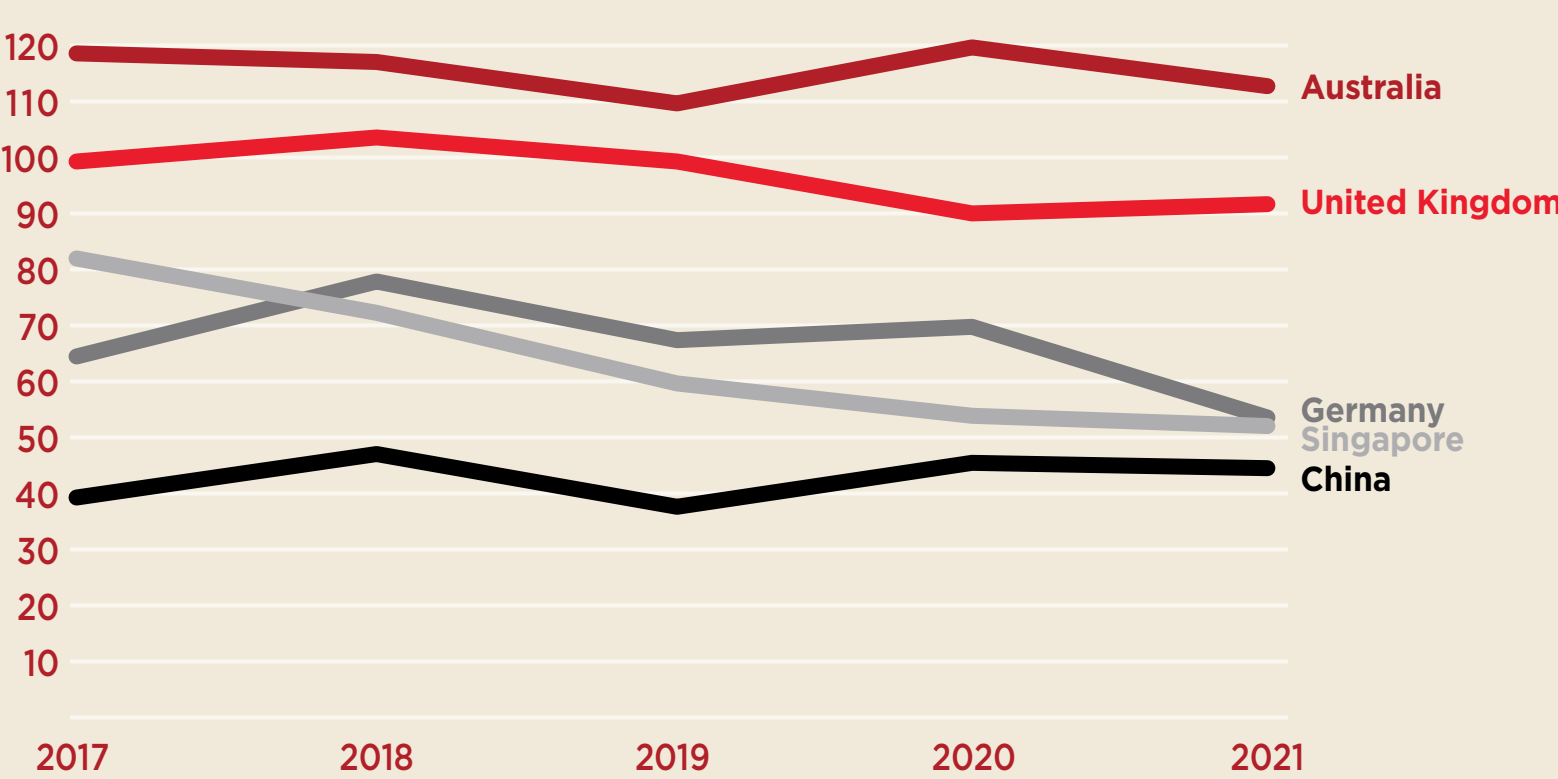


*NOTE: A SIOP Membership year is defined as the date range beginning March 1st and ending with the following June 30th (e.g., 2021 membership = invoice paid date 3/1/2020 to 6/30/2021). Any person who canceled their membership was removed. For any member who changed membership types within a year, their highest type was reported in the above analyses.

Though there has been a decrease in overall membership over the past three years, each membership category has remained consistent, fluctuating less than a percentage point between 2019 and 2021.

Excluding the U.S. and Canada, which made up the largest proportion of our members (81% and 3% respectively), the following five countries have the largest proportion of members and, notably, the greatest amount of change year-over-year.

Number of International Members from Top 5 Countries (Excluding Canada), 2017-2021



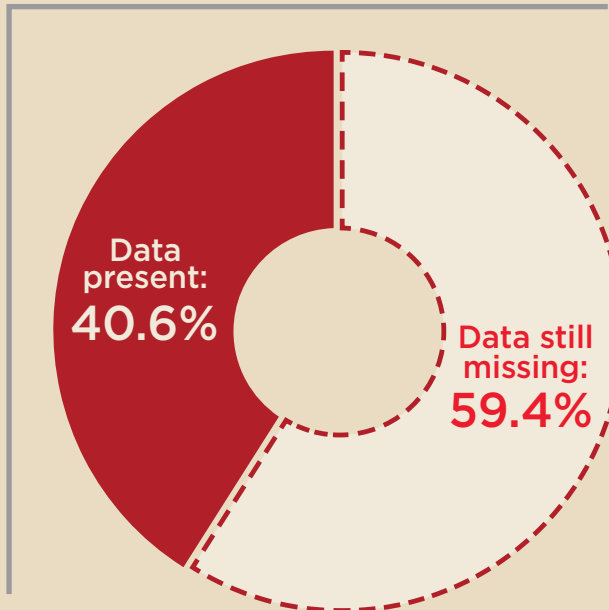
SIOP MEMBERS: TAKE ACTION!

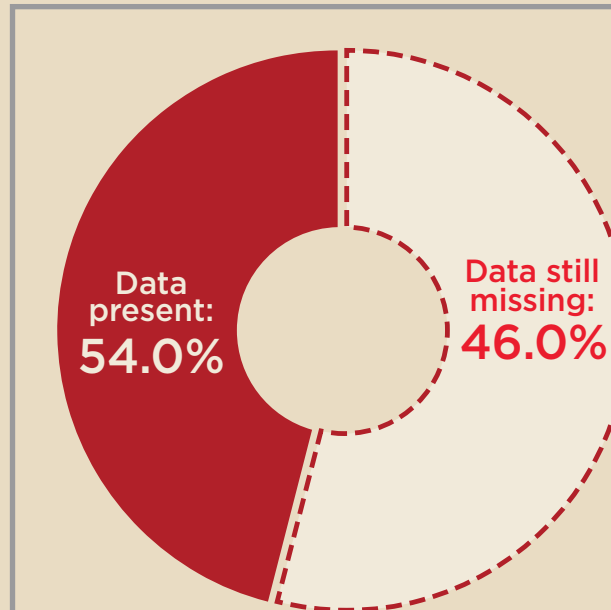
Please follow these steps to check that you have reported your information:
