

### Response Rate




#### Methodology

- 59 people responded to the survey.




## Which of the following describes your most recent membership status?






## How long were you a member of SIOP (including time as a Student Affiliate)?







### Membership Status & Tenure



## Which of the following best defines your race or ethnicity? Select all that apply.




## Which of the following best defines your current gender identity? Select all that apply.








### Please explain your intentions to rejoin or not rejoin in the future.
